

TASL Reporting of COVID-19 Exposure Policy

Any player, coach or staff member who has tested positive for COVID-19, are exhibiting signs or symptoms of COVID-19, or have come in close contact with someone who has tested positive for or is displaying signs or symptoms of COVID-19 are required to report this to TASL by completing the Google Form at: <u>Tidewater Advance Soccer League Wellness Report</u>

In accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) the identity of the individual and all medical information will be kept confidential and will only be shared with local health officials, if required.

Upon receipt of a completed form, ALL TASL Club representatives will be notified automatically via Google Forms. A copy of this form will also be sent to email: taslhealth@gmail.com

It is the responsibility of ALL TASL Club representatives to review ALL form submissions to determine if this has affected past or will affect future opponents within their clubs' scheduled TASL competition. This is a transparency measure for the health and safety of our community.

TASL Club representatives will then communicate to past and/or future opponents within their clubs that could be affected by reported exposure. TASL is exempt from determining quarantine windows as this would be handled through each club's individual COVID policy.

Future opponents will have the opportunity to decide whether they WILL participate as scheduled or WILL NOT participate as scheduled. TASL club representative will be required to respond with their club's decision to taslhealth@gmail.com.

If a club WILL NOT participate as scheduled, TASL schedules will be amended and potential make-ups evaluated. It is not guaranteed that the canceled game will be rescheduled. TASL will attempt to guarantee a minimum of 6 games in the face of a global pandemic.
